PLAN

Our specialists work directly with customers to identify improvements while our engineers lead the industry on key environmental performance indicators including alternative resource recovery strategies and new waste management technologies.

EDUCATE

Through ongoing community consultation and education programs, education centres and facility open days we inform the community about our operations and encourage improved recycling behaviours.

TREAT

Environmental monitoring helps to develop treatment plans to minimise and manage odour, dust, noise and litter in and around our facilities; manage storm and wash water runoff; ensure our work is not impacting soil or ground water; and reduce greenhouse gas emissions from both our fleet and our facilities.

REMEDIATE

At the end of their useful life we return our landfill facilities to a standard which meets our environmental obligations - and maintain a 30-year commitment to the ongoing monitoring and management of these facilities.
