- Operational Updates:
- Current Operational Activities; continue filling at top of landfill from south to north, with approximately 16m of fill remaining in the centre, tapering away. Expected completion June/July pending volume.
- Changes to Operations;
  1. Cell 7 commencement; license likely to be granted between 7<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> May. Likely to operate 2 cells concurrently whilst fluff layer is constructed
- Planning Applications;
  1. Previous minuted applications are with consultant planner – waiting final consultancy reports to enable submission, likely May/June
    1. Crushing and screening
    2. Tonnage to 390ktpa
    3. Re-use (Cat 61A)
    4. Hrs – 6am to 8pm
- Environmental Applications;
  1. As per planning application above.
  2. Will look to reopen cell 1 – no progress; sitting with engineering for design
- Environmental Management and Compliance Update:
  1. CCA treated wood samples currently with consultant for leachability testing – awaiting results
  2. Radiation monitoring completed March – no issues to report, not yet uploaded to web page
- Groundwater Monitoring;
  1. April ground water monitoring regime completed ; no issues to report, not yet uploaded to web page
- Stormwater Management and Monitoring;
  1. Intended southern stormwater drain has not been commenced; design received from Consultant, however conservation side remains the barrier to long term solution. Currently sitting with engineering
  2. Stormwater ponds are low (as planned for start of winter). Will utilise leachate on tipface if required.
  3. Silt traps cleaned out in April
- Dust Management;
  1. Awaiting feedback from shire on submitted DMP.
  2. Impact of clay as cover versus flock, realizes dust in summer/mud in winter.
  3. Mulch spread on northern facing batter as dust control
- Litter Management;
  1. 3m high fence x 300m long installed from leachate ponds up southern boundary bund wall providing protection to conservation park
  2. 250m of 6m temporary fencing installed at top of face providing protection from east and south easterly. To be repositioned when operating solely in cell 7
  3. Activ continues to be engaged
- Landfill Remediation;
  1. Nil to report,
