EXECUTIVE APPOINTMENTS

Cleanaway Waste Management Limited (ASX:CWY) today announces key leadership appointments as the company positions for further growth opportunities and the benefits of increased scale.

Tracey Boyes has been appointed to the role of Executive General Manager, Solid Waste Services. She will lead a business that operates Australia's largest solid waste and recycling collections fleet, integrated with leading resource recovery and post-collections facilities, including the Sydney post-collection assets that were recently acquired from Suez. Michele Mauger has been appointed Chief People Officer. Ms Mauger is currently the Chief People Officer at Incitec Pivot and has broad ranging experience across major organisations in sectors including natural resources, engineering, construction and hospitality. She will lead the human resources functions across the entire organisation and support the CEO and business unit leaders in driving a high performance and inclusive culture at Cleanaway.

The appointments follow the resignations of Mark Crawford as Executive General Manager, Solid Waste Services and Johanna Birgersson, Executive General Manager, Human Resources. Mr Crawford and Ms Birgersson will be available through the first quarter of 2022 to assist in an orderly transition to Ms Boyes and Ms Mauger, respectively.

Mr Schubert said, "I would like to thank Mark and Johanna for their significant contributions over many years to Cleanaway. Mark has led the Solid Waste Services business since 2016 and hands over a business that has a strong operational track record and delivery focus, and one which is set for continued growth.

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Johanna has played a key role in the development of the organisation since taking on the role in late 2015, a period in which the Cleanaway workforce more than doubled. I wish them all the very best in their future endeavours."

Ms Boyes and Ms Mauger will separately commence at Cleanaway early in the new calendar year.

Brendan Gill postponed his previously announced retirement to take on the role of Chief Operating Officer in early 2021 to support the CEO transition and to see the acquisition of Suez assets in Sydney through to completion. He will now retire towards the end of the first quarter of 2022.

Mr Schubert said, "I would like to thank Brendan for the support that he has provided me over the last few months and the significant contributions he has made to Cleanaway. Brendan took on the CFO role in 2014 and played a key role in our Footprint 2025 strategy, which has set Cleanaway up to be ready for its next stage of growth. We wish him well in his retirement."
